Rental assistance in Portland Oregon and Multnomah County.

Find short to midterm programs that offer rental assistance in Portland Oregon. Several different non-profit organizations, charities, churches social service agencies and government programs may be able to provide funds so people can prevent evictions and also pay their monthly rent. In addition, many of the Portland housing assistance agencies can also offer case management and referrals to services such as Section 8 housing vouchers or security deposit assistance programs.

Typically qualified applicants in Multnomah County can receive rent assistance for at most two years, however it is usually for a shorter period of time. While the exact terms and conditions will vary, it can include temporary assistance with paying rent or mortgage payments, motel or hotel vouchers, funds to pay security deposits, and emergency eviction prevention assistance. In addition, referrals can be given to low income housing or apartments in the city of Portland.

DDSD may be able to provide a limited amount of short-term housing and rent assistance to participants who are at risk of homelessness or evictions.
